Comments to the Author

The title needs to be correctly punctuated
you need to tell the reader about BEP and DEBC as readers will have no understanding of these concepts.

reconsider sentence construction in abstract - some very long sentences.

Introduction - paragraph 4 - reconsider the word 'worse'

pg 4 - reconsider the term - 'true mothers'

pg 5/6 - please review sentence construction at the end of pg 5 and beginning of pg6, it doesn't read as you think.

Tables are clear - which is good

This is a very interesting topic

You mention the first 1000 days - it might be good to elaborate on this and to possibly link it to bonding and attachment in relation to psychological factors for both Mum and baby.

Your description of the baby sling used needs to come towards the beginning of the paper

You should mention that the sling also offers 'close contact' which will also increase oxytocin

You should rethink your sentence construction in areas and how the paper is constructed, I feel the detail of the sling should at the beginning.

Comments to the Author

Thank you for choosing the journal for this interesting report. It seems to me that you have important work to share, and I would like to see it published.

The English language is a problem. We don't mind this since we welcome international contributions and have an international audience. However, it is important that such readers from around the World are able to understand the work in what is possibly a second or third language for them. If you could get a native English speaker to review the manuscript with you while you explain what you mean to say and they amend the text to more standard English expression the quality of the writing would match the quality of the study. I would then be able to provide much more useful feedback and detail of amendments in preparation for what I am confident would be eventual publication.

A few specific points for now.

- (1) You wait until a few lines before the conclusion to explain what is meant by the apron and what its purpose is.
- (2) Connected to this - ensure that terms used in the abstract match what is used in the main text (Sling, apron, DEBC).
- (3) There is a sentence of 87 words in the abstract - normal people can't keep so much in mind while they make sense of what you are saying.
- (4) Since it is a key term... "exclusive breastfeeding" (not "breastfeeding exclusive").
- (5) (Introduction) Para 2, lines 22-24 seem to be contradictory.
- (6) First paragraph of "Results" is repeated and unnecessary.
- (7) Some element of Table 1 require attention - SD of 6131? The labelling in column 1 goes wrong - "Group v Intervention Group".
- (8) Significance should be reported simply as "p=???" rather than "p value > ..."
- (9) It may be confusing to reverse the order of intervention and control group just in Table 3.
- (10) You should be consistent in the referencing - For several items you list only "PubMed" rather than the journal name. Authors should be in full in the list. Many items are not in English. I will ask the editorial team if approximate translations are needed or not.

I hope that you will persist, sort out the English, and then be able to work with the reviewers to get the work into publication.
